As students at Cornelius Hope Academy Secondary School complete Form IV by passing the “O” level program, they need financial support to continue on to “A” level programs that will lead to opportunities at the university or technical college level or to post secondary school courses that provide employment opportunities. There are currently 16 students in post secondary education including vocational training and university, who have grown up at the Village of Hope, Zimbabwe. These students were able to go to school because of sponsorship through the Child Care Plus Program and they now need financial assistance to continue their educational journey. The purpose of the Educational Fund is to provide the finances to allow these students to continue their education past the form IV level through sponsorship commitments. Sponsors can contribute all or part of the amount needed as their finances allow. Contributions can be made through Villages of Hope Africa by monthly Pre-Authorized bank Debits or by Credit Card. Please make certain to direct all contributions to “Educational Fund-Zimbabwe”. Sponsors will receive a tax receipt from VOH Africa for their support and should expect to receive regular communication in the form of a newsletter from the students being sponsored through this fund. One time donations can be made payable to Mission Zimbabwe and 100% will be forwarded to the Village of Hope, Zimbabwe Education Fund.

I have completed my 'O' level and am going to Mount Pleasant High School for my 'A' level. After High school I would like to go to university to study Environmental management, social work or even law.


### Vivian

6. For those students advancing to University, they must have attained 5 points and above
7. For those not advancing either to university or grade 12 and 13, they must have passed 5 or more subjects to go to either a tertiary college or a trade college.
